The purpose of the scheduled meeting is to present and solicit ideas regarding:

- Parameters for providing access to the human remains at the temporary storage facility at the Museum of Natural History
- Process of determining the historic cemetery boundaries
- Concepts for the Re-interment Plan to guide the appropriate and respectful re-interment of excavated human remains and associated cultural artifacts on site
- Plans for an on-site design element to commemorate and honor the people laid to rest in the historic cemetery
- Considerations for the development of a Cultural Resources Management Plan to provide for long-term preservation and interpretation of the cultural resources at the site

This meeting is part of the County and the LA Plaza de Cultura y Artes Foundation's ongoing commitment to having an open and transparent dialogue about the discovery of human remains and artifacts, and other development-related activities at the Project site. The County is commencing an official consultation process in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, as requested by the National Park Service, Native American groups, and other interested parties. As requested by the Native American Heritage Commission and the National Park Service, the County is committed to creating a consultation process that is inclusive of the many parties who have expressed an interest in resolving these issues, including the Catholic Archdiocese, Los Pobladores, and all of the Native American groups identified by the Commission.

The County Hall of Administration is centrally located in downtown Los Angeles, immediately south of the Hollywood (101) Freeway.

If arriving via:

Harbor (110) North – Take Harbor North and follow signs to Santa Ana (5) South/San Bernardino (10) East. Exit Temple Street. Turn left on Temple Street. Turn right on Grand Avenue. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Hollywood (101) North – Take Hollywood North. Exit Grand Avenue. Turn right on Grand Avenue South past Temple Street. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Hollywood (101) South – Take Hollywood South. Exit Temple Street. Turn left on Temple Street. Turn right on Grand Avenue. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Pasadena (110) South – Take Pasadena South to Santa Ana (5) South/San Bernardino (10) East. Exit Temple Street. Turn left on Temple Street. Turn right on Grand Avenue. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Santa Ana (5) North – Take Santa Ana North to Hollywood North. Exit Grand Avenue. Turn right on Grand Avenue South past Temple Street. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Golden State (5) South – Take Golden State South. Take Pasadena South. Take Santa Ana (5) South/San Bernardino (10) East. Exit Temple Street. Turn left on Temple Street. Turn right on Grand Avenue. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Santa Monica (10) East – Take Santa Monica East to Pasadena North. Take Santa Ana (5) South/San Bernardino (10) East. Exit Temple Street. Turn left on Temple Street. Turn right on Grand Avenue. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

San Bernardino (10) West – Take San Bernardino West to Hollywood North. Exit Grand Avenue. Turn right on Grand Avenue South past Temple Street. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Pomona (60) West – Take Pomona West to Hollywood Freeway North. Exit Grand Avenue. Turn right on Grand Avenue South past Temple Street. Park at the Music Center on the right-hand side of Grand Avenue. Parking is approximately \$9.00.

Via Metro Red Line (Subway) – Exit at Civic Center (Hill Street). Take Hill Street north. Turn left on Temple Street. Hall of Administration is on the left-hand side of Temple Street.

Please enter the County Hall of Administration through Temple Street entrances. Check in at the security desk. Directional signage will be present to the elevators to the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor to Room 140.
